A national phenomena, a decline in GPA a student's first semester

Causes of "Transfer Shock":

- New Environment
- Navigating different academic policy and expectations
- Academic Rigor/Advanced Courses in Major
- Large Classes
- Unaware or underutilization of Resources
- Imposter Syndrome
- Connection to faculty and peers
